

Community-Wide Cornhole Tournament Rules



1. Each match is played at 27 feet, front board to front board. Any bags are allowed if they are filled with resin beads and not corn. If you do not have your own bags, they will be provided.
2. You must stand across from your partner.
3. To start a game, you can either rock paper scissors or spin a bag. A bag-spin will be demonstrated for you. Whoever wins this will throw the first bag.
4. You will alternate throwing all 4 bags with the opponent next to you. Once all bags are thrown, you will score the round.
5. If a bag was knocked off or fell off the board, it does not count in scoring.
6. You will net the score of the board as it stands, a bag on the board being 1 point and a bag in the hole being 3.
7. To determine the score for the round, take your total minus your opponent's total. (Examples: Player A had 1 bag in the hole and 2 on the board. Player B had 2 bags in the hole and 1 on the board. Player A has 5 and Player B has 7. The score will be 2 for Player B).
8. Whichever team scored will throw the first bag on the next round. If the score nets to zero, you will maintain the first person throwing as it was in the previous round.
9. Play goes until 21 no-bust, or to a time limit that will be set by tournament officials. Tournament format will also be based on registration and event time.
